#### UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE LETTER CARRIER SENTENCED

#### FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

**GERONIMO A. CELLAMARE**, age 46, a resident of Jefferson Parish, was sentenced today in federal court before U.S. District Judge Helen G. Berrigan to conspiracy to unlawfully delaying United States mail, announced United States Attorney Jim Letten.

**CELLAMARE**, a United States Postal Service Letter Carrier, pled guilty on April 1, 2009 to a bill of information filed on February 2, 2009, charging him with unlawfully detained, delayed, secreted and destroyed approximately 2950 pieces of mail entrusted to him and which were intended to be conveyed by the United States mail.

**CELLAMARE** was sentenced to three (3) years active probation.

The case was investigated by the United States Postal Service-Office of Inspector General (OIG).

The case was prosecuted by Assistant U. S. Attorney Marvin Opotowsky.
